Steve McCarthy started making true Williams (Bartlett) eau de vie of pear in 1985 with two small pot stills he brought over from Germany. The marriage of Oregon fruit and European techniques and traditions has worked. The eau de vie include the original pear, a pear grown in the bottle, barrel-aged apple, kirschwasser, blue plum brandy and framboise. McCarthy makes grappa in the original Italian fashion, using pomace from many of Oregon's fine wineries. A traditional barrel-aged wine brandy (made from Oregon wine) and America's only true single malt whisky complete this line.
