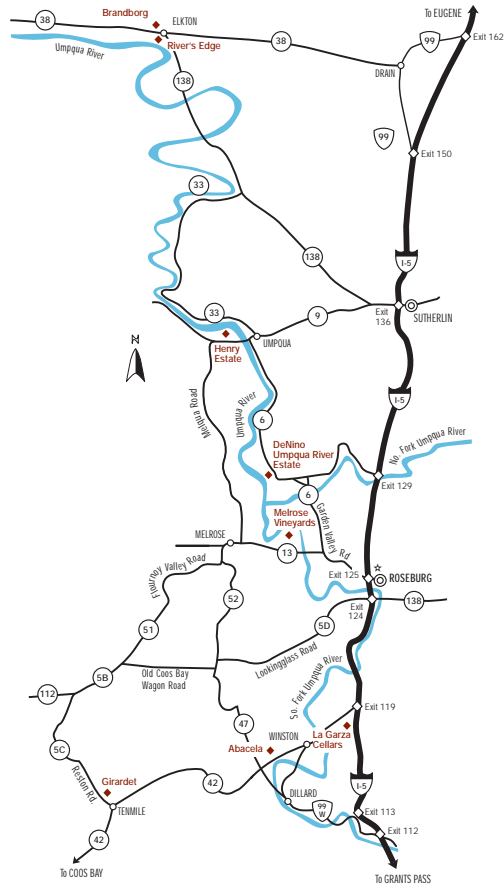

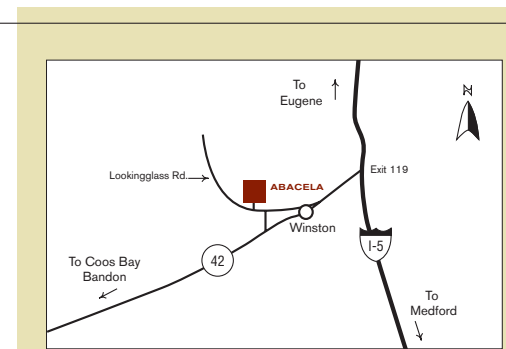

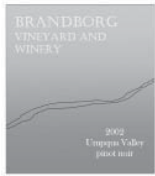
Visitors welcome: Tasting Room open daily, 11-5

An oenophile's list of wineries to visit in Oregon is not complete without Abacela. This is a family owned and operated winery with a total production of 5000 cases and distribution is limited. Here, on sunny south sloping rocky hills they grow Tempranillo, Syrah, Merlot, Dolcetto and other varietals carefully matched to a unique terroir and microclimate. The estate fruit is picked when optimally ripe and carefully vinified in small batches utilizing a gravity flow winery design. These handcrafted wines are aged to maturity in small oak casks. The results: big, bold deeply colored wines with intense varietal character. These wines, which are reflective of their terroir, have ample tannin and structure for aging. Abacela is well worth the visit.

River's Edge is a family-owned winery specializing in two varietals, Pinot noir and Gewürztraminer. The wines are produced from grapes grown in two estate vineyards, which were planted in 1973 and are among the oldest in Oregon. The winemaking style emphasizes a low-tech, handmade approach, with small-batch fermentation and aging exclusively in barrel. The tasting room, located at the winery overlooking the Umpqua River, offers older vintages and special bottlings.

La Garza is located less than 1/2 mile off of Interstate 5 at exit 119, five miles south of Roseburg. In addition to our tasting room and quality wines, La Garza features a restaurant serving lunch on the deck or in the dining room Wednesday through Sunday, May through September. The vineyard produces Cabernet, Merlot and Syrah. The winery produces Cabernet, Merlot, Dry Riesling, Pinot gris and "Rosado de la Casa" a dry white Cabernet. The great picnic area and covered deck as well as an excellent tasting room promises a more than worthwhile visit. RV parking is available.
